ADR Training

The ADR course runs over 5 days, Monday to Friday, with the exams being taken on the final day. The standard course includes the Core, Packages, Tankers modules and the 7 danger classes. The Explosives and Radioactive modules are separate so if you do have a requirement for these we can add them to the training.

The classes are detailed below:

Class 1	Explosives
Class 2	Gases
Class 3	Flammable liquids
Class 4	Flammable solids: substances liable to spontaneous combustion and substances that, in contact with water emit flammable gases
Class 5	Oxidising substances and organic peroxides
Class 6	Toxic and infectious substances
Class 7	Radioactive material
Class 8	Corrosive substances
Class 9	Miscellaneous dangerous substances and articles

Note: Class 1 and 7 are specialised courses and as such are not part of our normal programs.

Definitions:

Packages: (other than in tanks) means any goods that are not carried in a road tanker or tank container.

Bulk: (Packages regulations) Dangerous goods not in packaging, example Skips or Tippers.

Tanks: Tank and Tank Containers, any goods carried in a road tanker or tank container.
